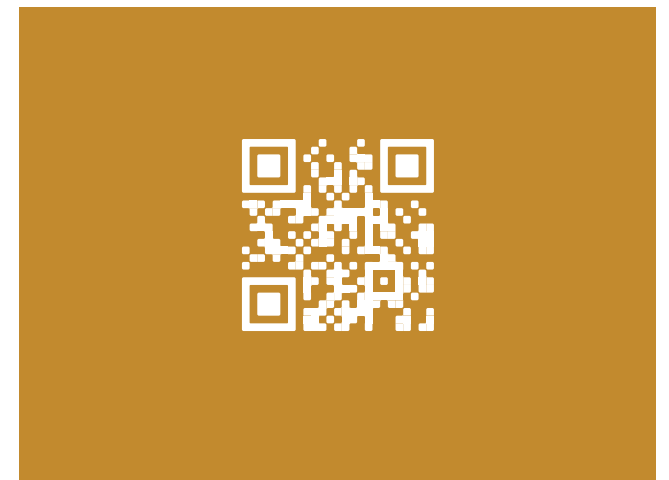
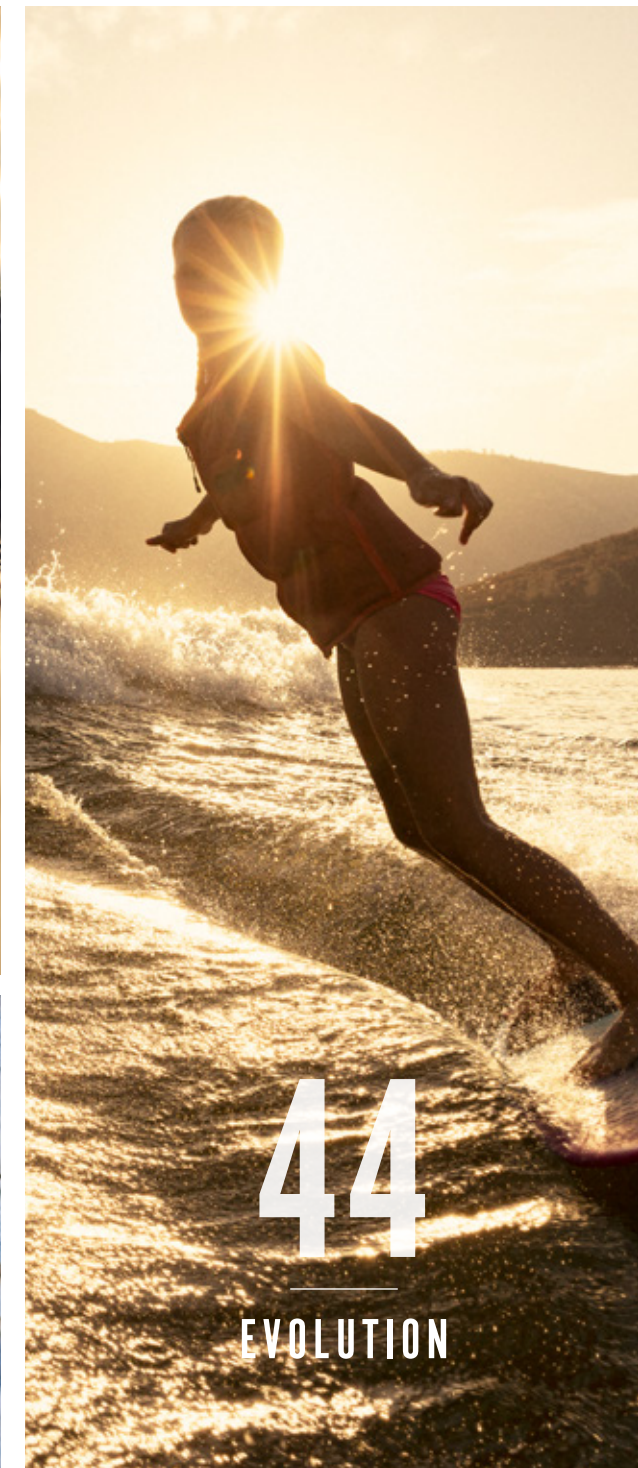

THE CENTURION Ri SERIES IS HIGH PERFORMANCE WRAPPED IN LUXURY

The Ri Series takes the utility of a high-performance boat and wraps it in a luxurious family boat. You still get the world's best waves, wakes and ride. You still get the most fuel efficiency on the market, but you also get all the extras that define the difference between the all-out sports model that is unapologetically designed for wake warriors and the luxury utility that pads performance in comfort and convenience. Whether you are just beginning your water sports journey, or you still compete, there's an Ri model to suit your needs.



The Ri Series models in 23, 24.5 and 26.5 feet lengths respectively, are collectively dominating wake machines that are a notch above. From the level running attitude to the low noise levels, everything about these boats feels right. Coupled with the world's best wakes, waves and a ride that cuts through chop like butter, plus the little touches found everywhere inside, they deliver performance enveloped in luxury.





OUR BASICS ARE BETTER

The standard appointments included in our Ri Series are well beyond what most customers expect. In addition to our ZZ5 5.3L PCM engine and Dropzone tower, we include additional touches that we know mean something to you and are designed to give you more of what you want – time on the water – with less time-consuming tasks in the way. The new vented windshield with available colored a-pillars can allow a breeze or shelters you from the wind. Custom stitching offers distinctive style, and a carefully disguised trash receptacle in the walkthrough area helps you keep things clean all day long. Our battery

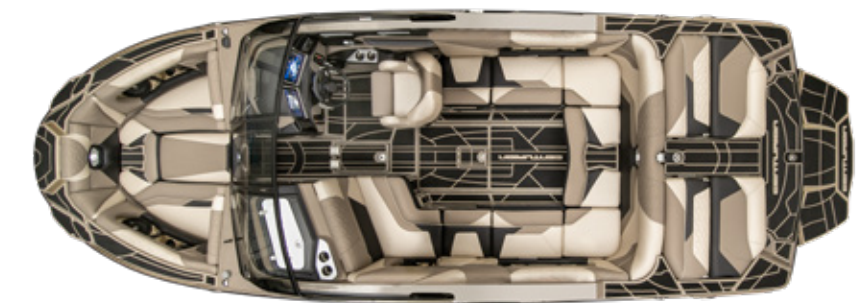
management system conveniently located in the glove-box puts control at your fingertips and saves time. How about an in-floor ice chest? Fill it up with wet or dry cargo and go! Ri side panels host a wireless charging system for your devices along with one in the glove box, while a driver's side remote with volume knob means quick control. The two 12-inch square screens on the dash with our ROV enable you see in front of and behind the boat including into the fuel system with real-time trip data. Ri Series models are designed to make things easier and more enjoyable so you can focus on fun.



The smallest of our Ri Series, the Ri230 merges the depth of the Ri Series with the convenience of a 23-foot size in an aggressive, head-turning style. Thanks to the Opti-V running surface, the versatile Ri230 is the official tow boat of both the World Wake Surfing Championship and the IWWF Wakeboard World Championships. The Centurion Opti-V Hull has hook which changes the running attitude of the boat to get the nose

down and the entire "v" of the running surface cutting through chop and/or displacing water for wake surfing and wakeboarding. The available QuickSurf Pro Surf System creates lift opposite the surfside with its long stainless-steel plates on the rear corners of the boat. This boat has generated buzz due to its remarkable ability to create the World's best waves even at only 23-feet, with up to 5400 pounds of ballast.

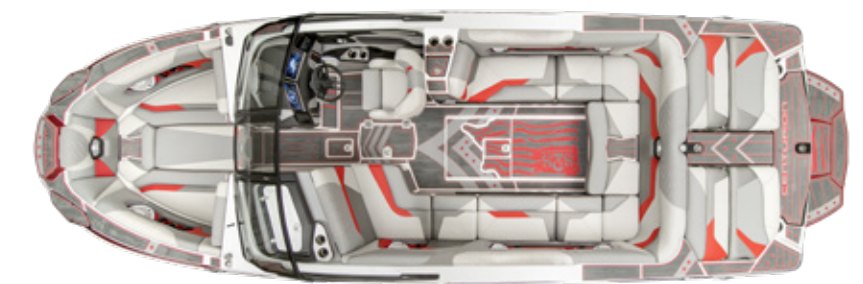

The large 16-person seating capacity doesn't leave anyone at the dock. A foot and a half longer than the industry's average size, the Ri245, Centurion's most sold model, offers up to seven precisely placed ballast locations, the industry's largest factory ballast capacity in a 24-foot boat, at 5650 pounds RAMFILL². The "Baller Ballast" system accounts for half that and fills in 90 seconds and bolsters reliability with

2" stainless steel ball valves for all four fill and drain gates. The Opti-V hull, with its 20 degrees of deadrise, delivers a smooth rough water ride, 50% better fuel efficiency and rapidly creates well-formed waves and symmetrical wakes. The exclusive Touch Revo Side by Side 12" x 12" HD dash system offers two screens mounted side by side and working together or independently for control and data feedback, including trip and fuel consumption. The DropZone auto tower, custom made for Centurion by Roswell, folds up quickly and smoothly at the push of a button.

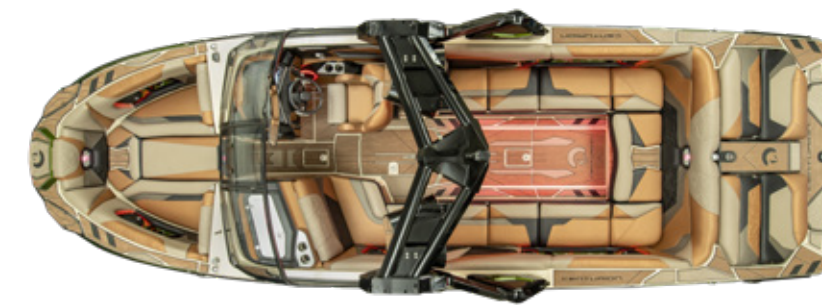

The Predator Power Tower (PPT) is dominant in the watersports boating market. Its power comes from the four Linak linear actuators, which work in perfect harmony, smoothly and noiselessly, to raise and lower the tower, all while keeping the PPT Convertible Bimini parallel to the floor, even when fully folded. Besides this exceptional functionality, the Predator tower includes specific hangers for wet towels, life vests, ropes and offers an optional set of fixed surf board racks, one each side, out of the direct sun. The rigid nine-foot Convertible Bimini can be trailered when up. When you are seeking some sun, the Predator Bimini has a convertible area easily unzipped to let in the light. When you're taking cover from rain, or going under a bridge, press the switch by the right knee of the driver down for protection. The Centurion Predator Power Tower by Roswell is also 100% made in the USA from the Permanent Mold casted base and top joints to the extruded metal for the middle section to the pristine, marine coating applied in either white or black.

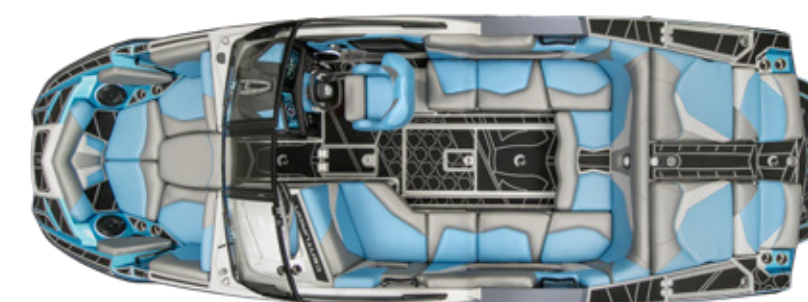

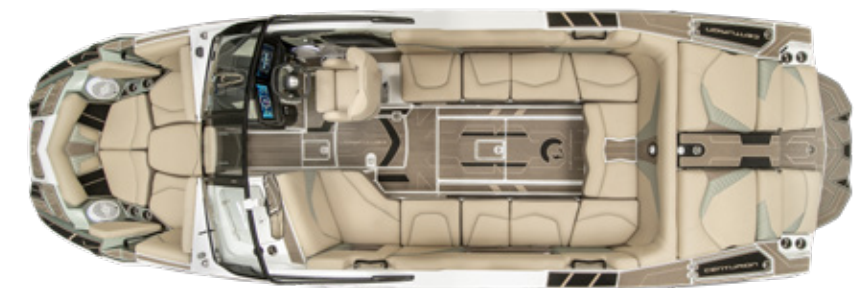

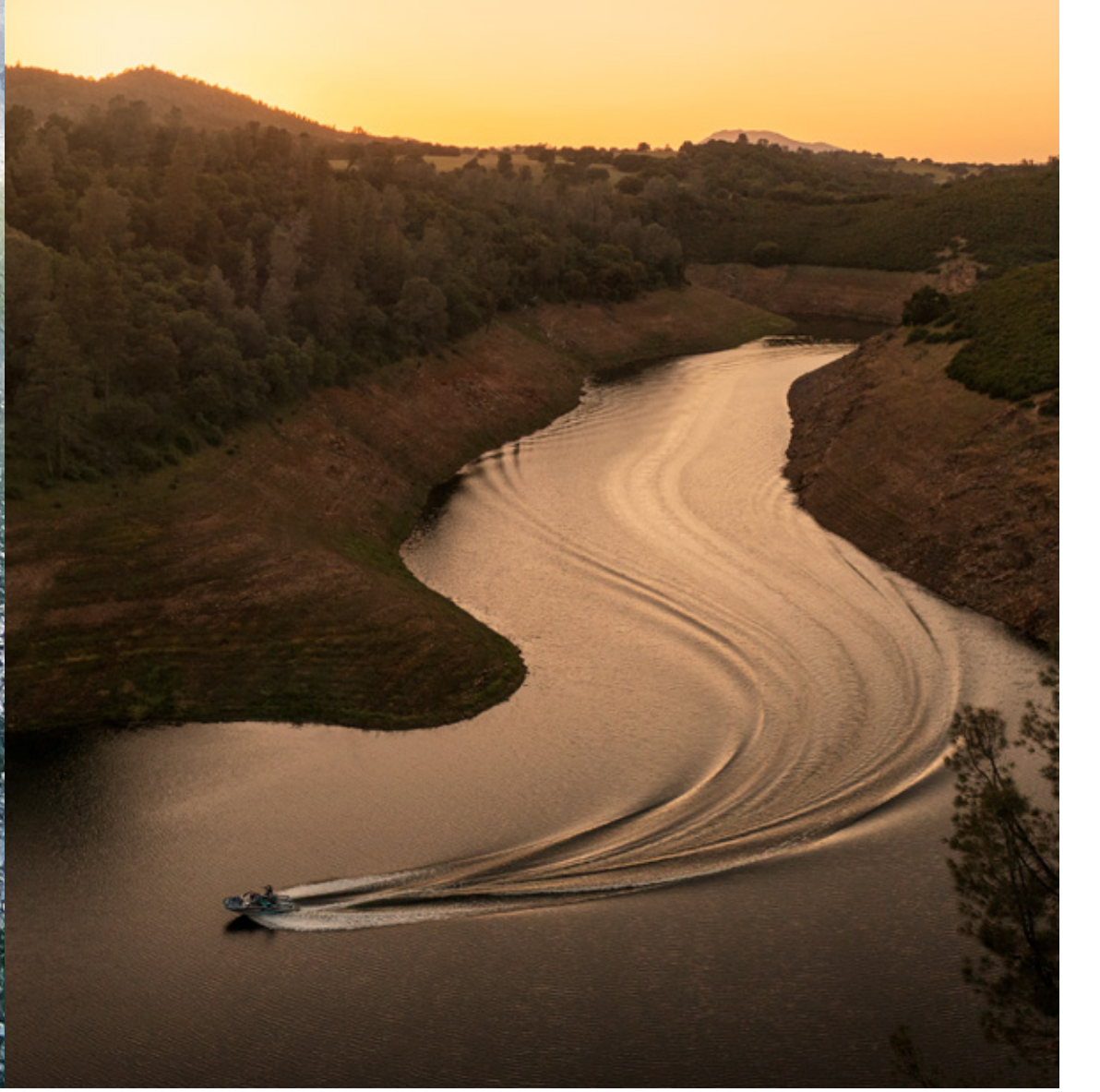

THE OPTI-V HULL IS THE SECRET SAUCE BENEATH THE SURFACE THAT SETS CENTURION APART

It's the key design that propelled Centurion to the top of wake sports. The history behind this remarkable innovation is interesting. Before wakeboarding and wake surfing, water skiing and barefooting water skiing were the most popular sports served by inboard water sports boats. Because these sports are best done when wakes are as flat as possible, hulls were designed to achieve that. Deep-v hulls were around, but they were used on runabouts, cruisers and off-shore boats that needed to cut through choppy water.



DELIVERING A SMOOTH ROUGH WATER RIDE AND CREATING ENVY WORTHY SURF WAVES AS WELL

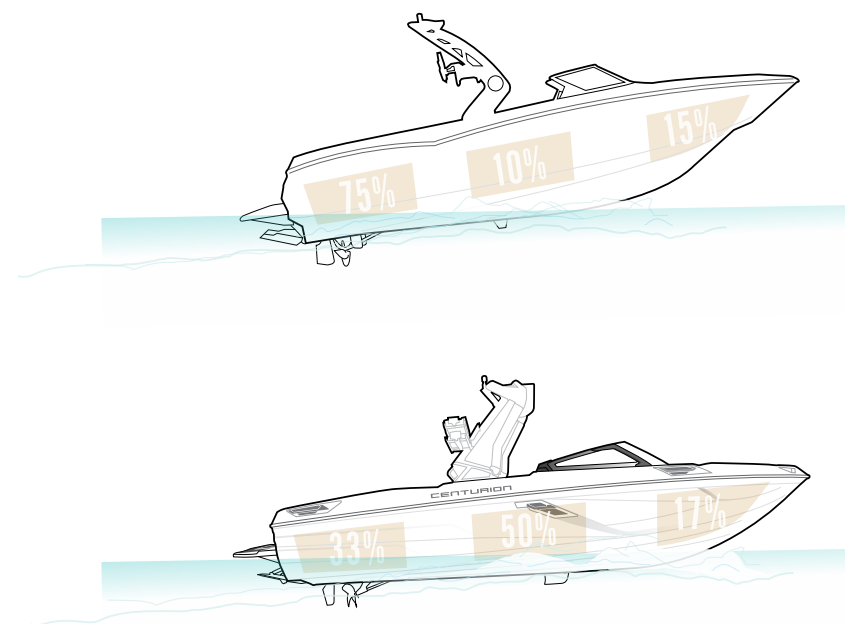
In the '90s, when wake sports were becoming popular, most towboat companies were focused on people who wanted flat wakes for water skiing. The deep-v running surface, by its very design, displaced more water for larger wakes. Recognizing the increasing interest in wakesurfing, Centurion Boats looked to the deep-v to find a way to generate larger wakes. By optimizing the deep-v with side-to-side balance they were able to generate symmetrical wakes and well defined waves when QuickSurf Pro causes the hull to list slightly towards the surf side creating a curl in the wave - ideal for surfing.





OUR BALLAST LOCATIONS ARE KEY TO OUR WORLD CLASS WAVES WAKES AND RIDE

The balanced running attitude created by the Opti-V is enhanced by our ballast locations and together they nearly eliminate bow rise when weighted to ride. Drivers can sit comfortably in place and see the water in front of them. You won't see the driver of a Centurion standing up when they tow a surfer because there is plenty of visibility and control from their seated position. This dynamic also allows a Centurion to displace water with the entire running surface creating a longer pushier wave. An additional benefit of this balanced attitude is remarkable fuel efficiency-up to 50% more than comparable boats. The engine doesn't have to work as hard to push through the water and therefore uses less fuel, which in turn leads to more time on the water between refills.



CENTURION DOES BALLAST DIFFERENTLY AND IT CREATES A BETTER EXPERIENCE FOR EVERYONE

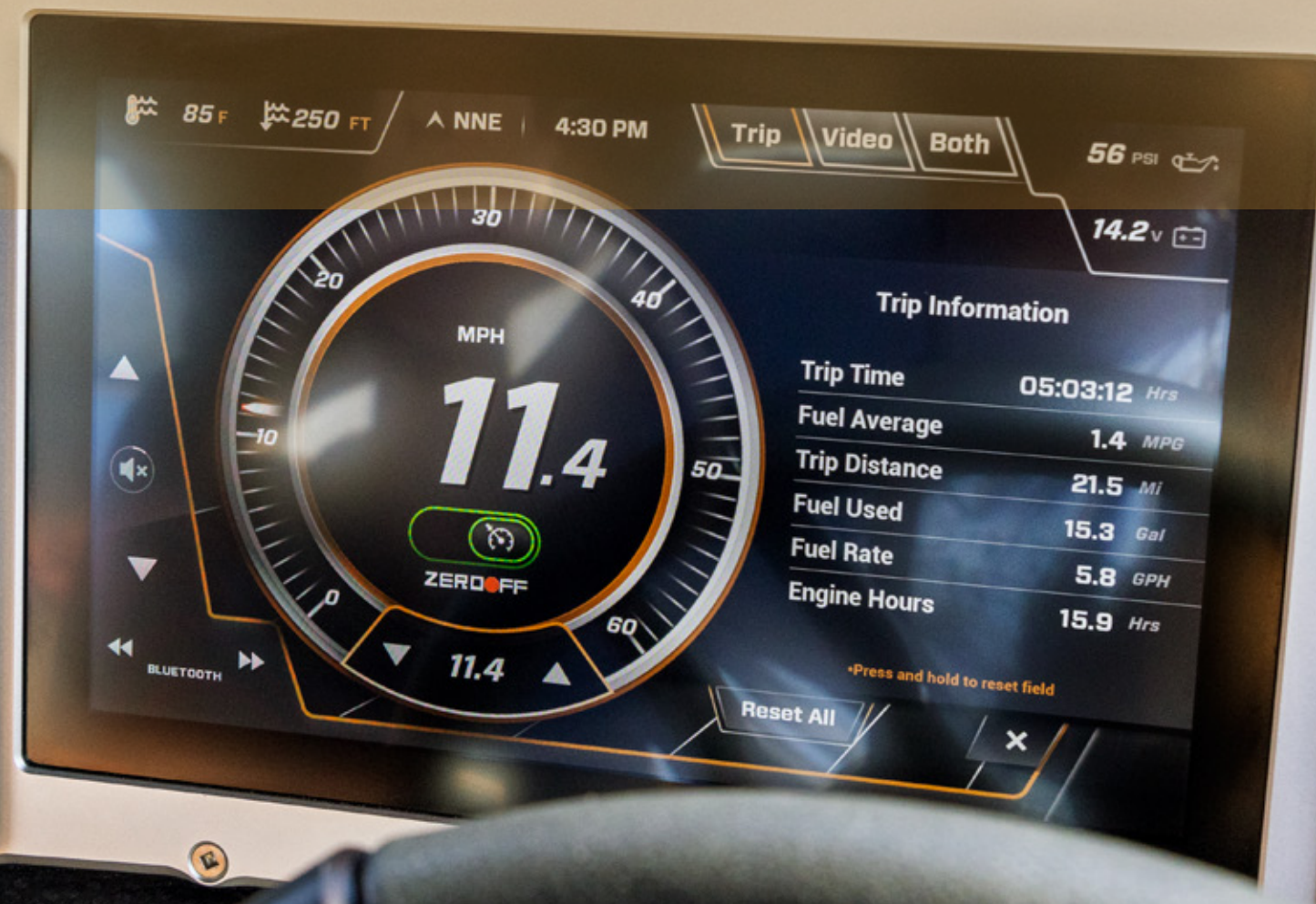
Centurion wants everyone to enjoy being on the water, so we approach ballast differently from other companies. All of the ballast available in Centurion boats (up to seven precisely placed hidden ballast locations that combine for up to 5850 pounds of ballast) is evenly distributed. Placed under the floor, it doesn't interfere with storage, or interior space. And because it goes along the length of the hull it creates longer waves. In the case of the Ri265 the wave extends more than 26 feet behind the boat. This evenly distributed weight creates consistent push from the face to the curl.

FUEL EFFICIENCY ISN'T OFTEN ASSOCIATED WITH SPORTS BOATS



BETTER FUEL EFFICIENCY MEANS MORE TIME ON THE WATER AT A LOWER COST

The incredible fuel efficiency of Centurion Boats – up to 50% more than comparable boats – is largely due to the design of our Opti-V hull. The hull, which has the v to slice through water, also has lift at the back of the boat that flattens the running attitude and enables it to cut through the water with the sharpest part of its keel. This eliminates the resistance created when excessive bow rise causes the boat to push water instead of slicing through it. In turn, this prevents the engine from working harder than necessary.

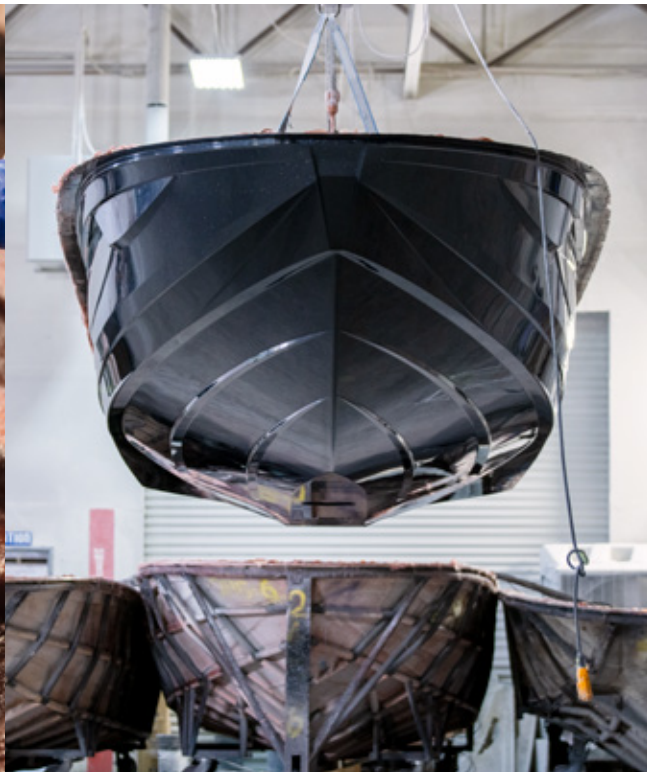


DROP INTO YOUR SWEET SPOT FOR THE RIDE OF YOUR LIFE

Centurion boats don't just create a sweetspot for wake surfing, which is usually just off the back of the swimstep. Unlike other towboats, Centurion offers a spectrum of surfable power, from the curl all the way up to the face of the wave. Athletes know when they have found the sweetspot in their sport, whether it's golf, tennis, or cycling. Ocean surfers know when they drop into a wave if they're in the right place to get a great ride. It's the same with surfing behind a boat and with our evenly distributed ballast the length of the displaced hull, Centurion has designed boats that extend that wave well beyond the length of waves behind most boats. It's more than 26 feet long and that gives surfers plenty of room to generate power for their next personal best or learn to throw the rope consistently.

It takes more than evenly distributed ballast to form a great wave and Centurion has pulled together all the elements to do that. The ballast creates the displacement, which is just the beginning. We weight the entire running surface down so it sits deeper in the water from bow to stern, accounting for the length of our wave. Then there's the push. Push, or the "hardness" of the entire wave, describes how well the water pushes the surfer along without letting them fall through the wave. Not enough displacement and the wave comes out soft with little push. Just the right amount of displacement and you get a hard wave with lots of momentum.





WE CARE THROUGH EVERY ASPECT OF THE BOAT BUILD

Once the custom gel coat colors are sprayed, backed by layers of engineered fiberglass cloth, and strengthened with the stringer system, your Centurion is pulled from its mold, revealing your custom design. Our craftspeople then progress the build to a finished product that meets your specifications. The hull is flipped over for access to the Opti-V running surface so the laser-aligned underwater gear, like the rudder, prop shaft, and the tracking fin or the available Centurion Articulating Tracking System (CATS) can be installed. Next the pumped ballast pick-up through-holes and the optional RAMFILL² scoop is installed. Then your boat is flipped back over and headed for artisan assembly to receive a perfectly balanced 6-point mounted Pleasure Craft Marine Engine and available RAMFILL² stainless steel fill and drain 2" ball valves. Simultaneously, your Roswell Tower is assembled for aluminum-backed through-bolted installation. During a factory tour you would see caring people intensely focused on their role. Unlike car manufacturers who stamp out the same product through automated systems, the boats we build reflect our dedication to customization and quality craftsmanship. There are real people behind your boat. They want it to be exactly what you imagined and more. They check and double check their work. They set high expectations for themselves. Customers are like family. They want you to be proud.

Choosing boat colors is like choosing house colors — you're likely going to live with them for a while. Once you've run the same line for a while, move on to another area. Remember, you are responsible for your own wake.
